Fortnightly Selection Statistics – 10 August 2011

1. Selection 10 August 2011– Skilled Migrant Category

The most recent selection of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) under the Skilled Migrant Category took place on 10 **August 2011**.

- **342** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **140** or above;
- **234** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand.

As a result, **576** EOIs representing **1,246** people were selected and will now undergo preliminary verification to determine if an invitation to apply for residency will be issued.

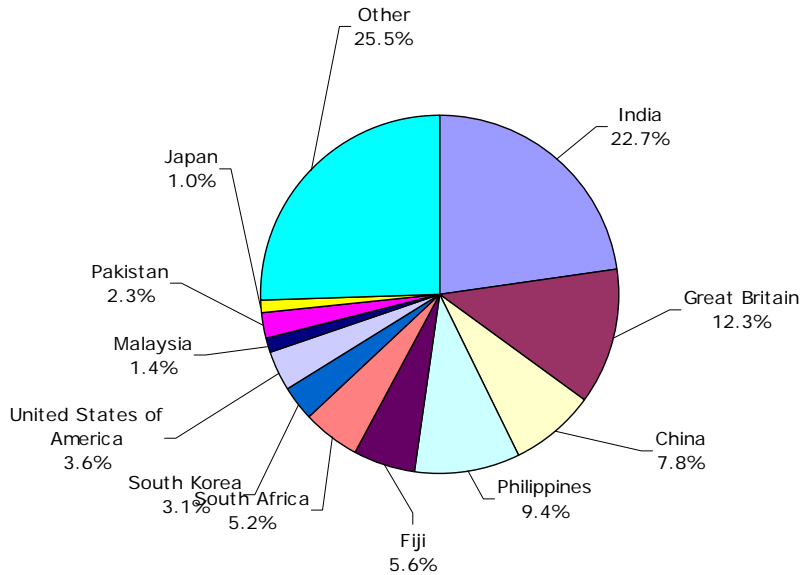
2. The make-up of selection

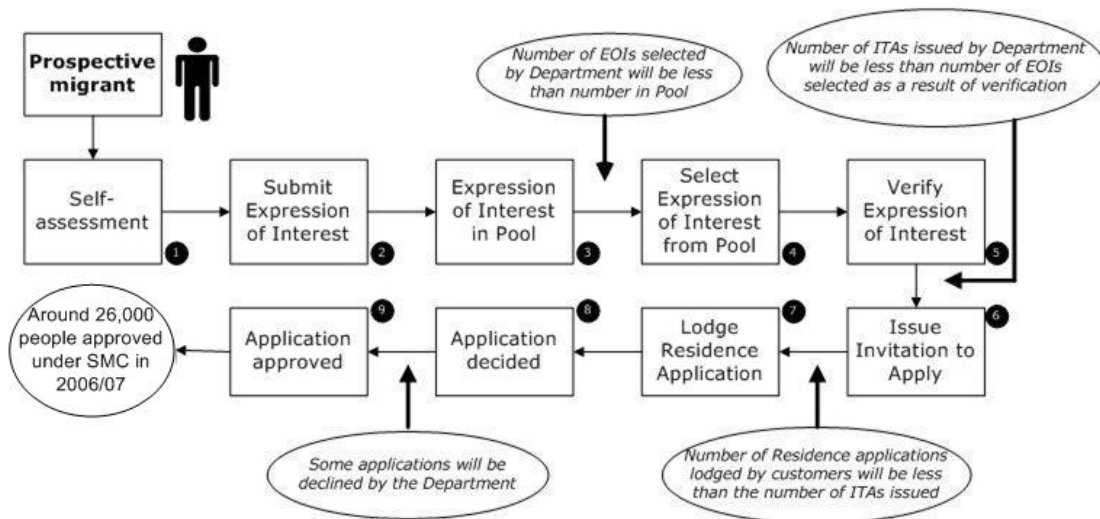
**Expressions of Interest Selected
