

## New Zealand Residence Programme

### *Fortnightly Selection Statistics – 1 June 2011*

---

#### 1. Selection 1 June 2011– Skilled Migrant Category

The most recent selection of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) under the Skilled Migrant Category took place on **1 June 2011**.

- **401** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **140** or above;
- **106** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand.
- **50** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **120** or more but less than 140, and included 15 bonus points for work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage.

As a result, **557** EOIs representing **1122** people were selected and will now undergo preliminary verification to determine if an invitation to apply for residency will be issued.

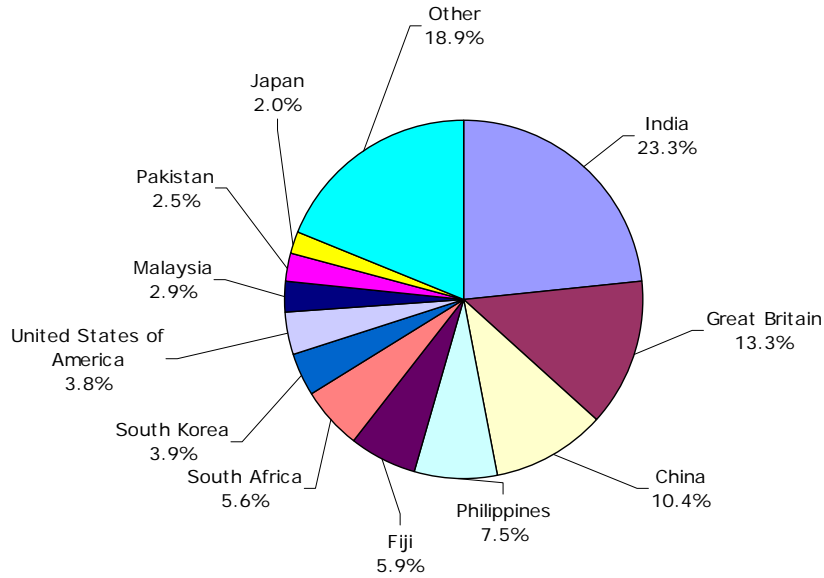
#### 2. The make-up of selection

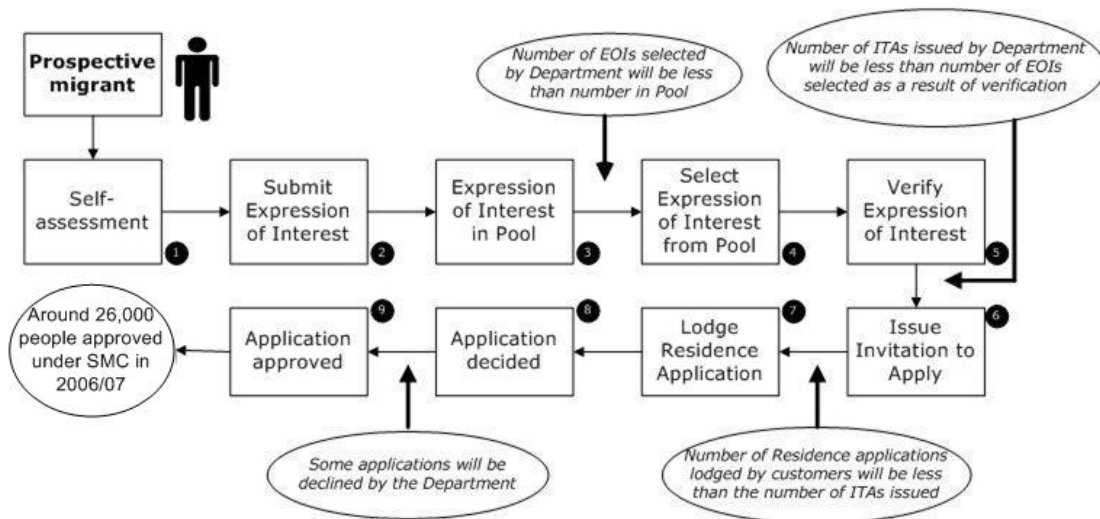
**Expressions of Interest Selected**
