Fortnightly Selection Statistics – 8 September 2010

1. Selection 8 September 2010– Skilled Migrant Category

The most recent selection of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) under the Skilled Migrant Category took place on **8 September 2010**.

- **389** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **140** or above;
- **116** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand.
- **50** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **120** or more but less than 140, and included 15 bonus points for work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage.

As a result, **555** EOIs representing **1160** people were selected and will now undergo preliminary verification to determine if an invitation to apply for residency will be issued.

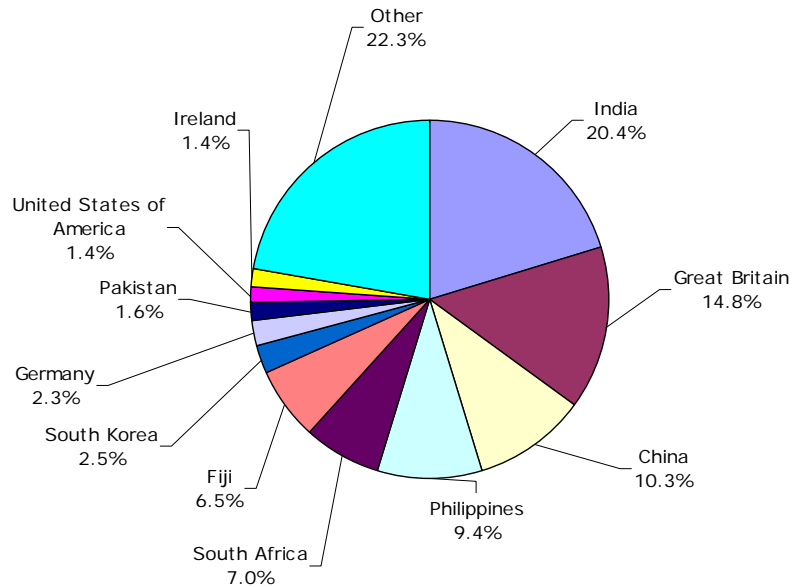
2. The make-up of selection

8 September 2010**

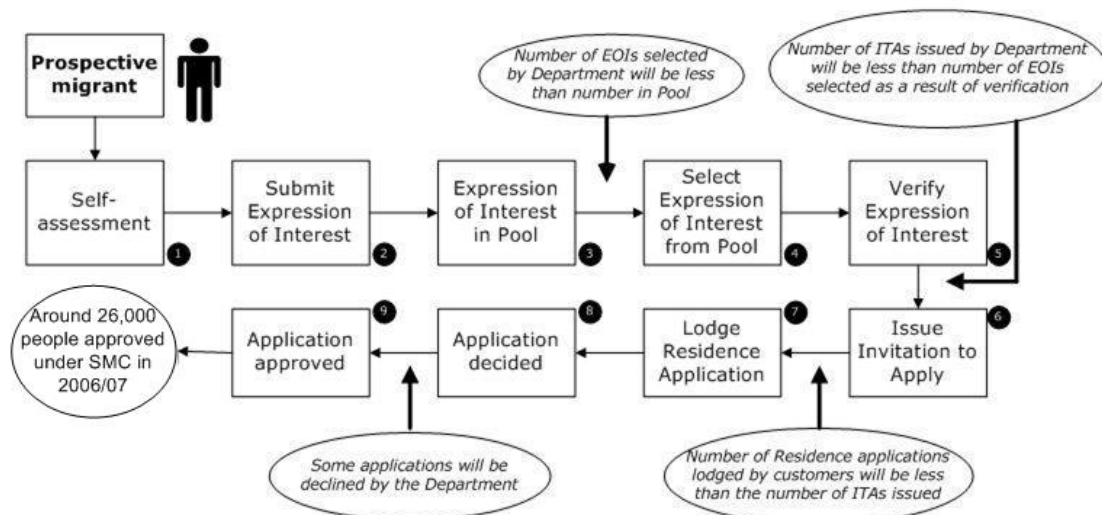


4. Statistics since December 2003

Since the Skilled Migrant Category opened in December 2003, a total of **117,789** EOIs, representing **272,589** people, have been selected

Approximately **97 percent** of those EOIs selected have been verified (stage five below).
